



Cluster information for 1.1. and 1.2.

- 1.1: Classify Information sheets, novels, TV-programs, manuals, newspaper articles, opinion piece, poem, magazine article, weather report, train timetable, recipe, e-mail from a friend
- 1.2. Define skimming (reading rapidly for the main points)
  - Define scanning (reading rapidly to find a specific information)
  - Define intensive Reading (reading a short text for detailed information)
  - Define extensive reading (reading a longer text often for pleasure emphasis overall meaning)

Cluster information for 1.5.

- 1.5.1 Explain that it takes much longer to read a novel in a foreign language than reading a novel in your native language
- 1.5.2. Explain that you don't have to understand every word
- 1.5.3. Explain that you have to decide if you need to understand the word to grasp the gist of the main points
- 1.5.4. Explain that an unknown word that you see often in the text should be looked up
